

Member Build Spotlight

Mark Wechsler submitted the following photos and his thoughts about a plane that he recently finished. Thank you Mark for taking the time to share with us your beautiful plane. Best of luck on your maiden!





This is a Spitfire Mk IX that I just finished. It is based on a laser cut reproduction of the Top Flite Gold Edition Spitfire. It was made-to-order from Planesgoneby.com. The build occurred over the last 1 ½ years

The quality of the kit was excellent. All laser cut parts were vacuum packed and clearly labeled.

It is all balsa wood with a fiberglass cowl from Fiberglass Specialties, Robart retracts, and a DLE-20 gas engine.

I did make a number of modifications to handle of all electronics for the receiver, fiber optic isolation, electronic ignition, and electronic gear sequencer as well as incorporation of two batteries and changes to the firewall, cowling, and split flaps. There are also numerous small plastic fittings and grommets as well as the cockpit gauges that came from my 3D printer. The decals and lettering were created from either vinyl or covering using my Cricut Maker 3.

I'm happy with the end result but I'll be terrified to take-off the first time but I always am!







Photos From Our Last Meeting's "Show and Tell"
